

DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE 6 PEOPLE GITE

This gite is located in a building and a site both inscribed in the Historical Monuments register. It offers you modern comfort inside the original architecture of a former nineteenth century sheepfold. Its terrace in the garden opens on a park equally inscribed as HM and is equipped with complete garden furniture and a gas BBQ which you can appreciate on fair weather days.

Our hosts enjoy free access to the château's park and former vegetable garden also inscribed as HM.

Designed for 6 people this gite includes a 35m² living room with american kitchen and 3 bedrooms .

1 shower room 1 bathroom and 2 toilets

Private parking close by.

The kitchen is equipped with a fridge/freezer a dishwasher a washing machine with tumble dryer a microwave oven and of course a 4 lights cooker an electric oven and the necessary kitchenware.

In the living room a TV set with DVD player and a fireplace which can be supplied if you so wish with a cartload of firewood sold 10 €. Board games are also at hand.

The living room is on the ground floor as well as a bedroom with twin beds (90x200) and its shower room . There is also a separate toilet.

On the first floor 2 bedrooms with double bed (160x200) and a bathroom . There is also a separate toilet.

All bedrooms are fitted with drawers and closets. Bedlinen and pillows are supplied and beds are made up when you arrive.

Bedrooms are non smoking and pets not allowed.

Bathroom linen can be rented (3€ rental fee per person.)

Folding baby cots are supplied on request as well as high chair and change pad.

End of stay cleaning service is charged 50 € .

The house has central heating and each individual heater is fitted with its own thermostat.

A local tax is due in july and august and its rate is 0,50€ per night for each person over 13 years.

The gite stands 6 kms away from sea at Fort-Mahon, 9 kms from Berck and Rue (Somme). Montreuil-sur-Mer and Le Touquet are around 16kms, Abbeville at 30 et Boulogne at 60 kms.

A16/E402 motorway is close by. Exit 25 8 kms to the north and exit 24 17 kms to the south.

The lane leading to the gite is connected to RD 940 (between Berck and Rue) 2 kms south of Conchil le Temple or 700 m north of the bridge over the Authie river .

The lane entrance is in front of a big farm and next to the château's park and is marked out by a Gites de France sign.
