

DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE 8 PEOPLE GITE

This gite is located in a building and a site both inscribed in the historical monuments register. It offers you modern comfort inside the architectural structure of a former nineteenth century sheepfold. The terrace opens on a courtyard also inscribed in the HM register and is equipped with complete garden furniture and gas BBQ quite convenient on fair weather days.

Our guests enjoy free access to the château's park and former vegetable garden equally HM inscribed.

Designed for 8 people the gite includes an entrance and a 55m² dining lounge with separate kitchen and 4 bedrooms a shower room and a bathroom as well as 2 toilets. Private parking close by.

The kitchen is equipped with a fridge/freezer a dishwasher a washing machine with tumble dryer a microwave oven and of course a 4 lights cooker an electric oven and the necessary kitchenware.

In the living room a TV set with a DVD player and a fireplace which can be supplied if you so wish with firewood sold 10€ for a whole cartload. Board games are also at hand.

On the groundfloor there is on the left handside of the entrance and past the dining lounge a bedroom with twin beds (90x200) and to the right handside of the entrance and of the kitchen a toilet and a shower room.

On the first floor left handside a bedroom with twin beds (90x200) and right handside 2 bedrooms with double bed (160x200) a bathroom and a toilet. All bedrooms are fitted with drawers and closets. Bedlinen and pillows are supplied and beds are made up when you arrive.

Bedrooms are non smoking and pets not allowed.

Bathroom linen can be rented (3€ rental fee per person)

Folding baby cots are supplied on request as well as high chair and change pad.

End of stay cleaning service is charged 60€.

The house has central heating and each individual heater is fitted with its own thermostat.

A local tax is due in july and august and the rate is 0,50 per night for each person over 13 years.

The gite stands 6 kms away from sea at Fort-Mahon, 9 kms from Berck and Rue (Somme). Montreuil-sur-Mer and Le Touquet are around 16kms, Abbeville at 30 et Boulogne at 60 kms.

A16/E402 motorway is close by. Exit 25 8 kms to the north and exit 24 17 kms to the south.

The lane leading to the gite is connected to RD 940 (between Berck and Rue) 2 kms south of Conchil le Temple or 700 m north of the bridge over the Authie river .

The lane entrance is in front of a big farm and next to the château's park and is marked out by a Gites de France sign.
